

Tsunami appeal achievements in 2006

Maldives

- 216 houses complete
- Warehouse facilities on 6 islands
- Livelihoods consultancy and risk reduction assignment
- Cash grants for livelihoods – 75 groups covering 436 families across 4 islands
- Disaster management in 6 islands
- 287 individuals trained in first aid
- 18 students one year diplomas
- 3 safe play areas
- Agricultural inputs – 3,846 bags cow dung, 3,860 agricultural tools
- 3 new schools

Myanmar

- A health information system (HIS) as well as Community Health Workers and health facility monitoring, evaluation, and support systems developed and in the process of being implemented at the village and health facility level
- Establishment of baseline for the community's views of key family practices

Thailand

- Credit schemes operating in 12 communities; additionally occupational revolving funds
- 215 children are active, regular attendees in the learning centres; vocational schemes, such as the youth group furniture making, the fish cages, mushroom and tree nurseries and eco-tourism ventures
- HIV/AIDS interactive theatre in schools
- Training on child protection awareness, emergency preparedness
- 9 fishing shelters
- 4,927 households received psycho-social care
- Numerous villages committees and self help groups established
- Work with 500 Burmese migrant workers
